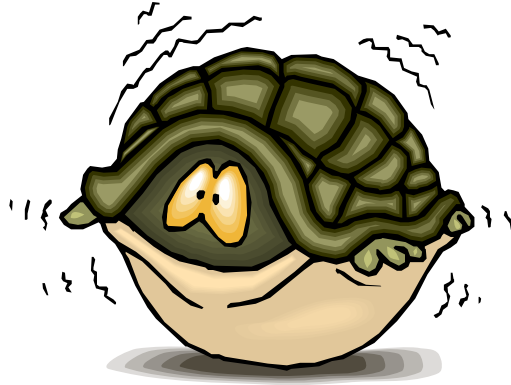
He knows every star and planet in the galaxy.
