Was it truth and understanding, things in them that wasn't found.

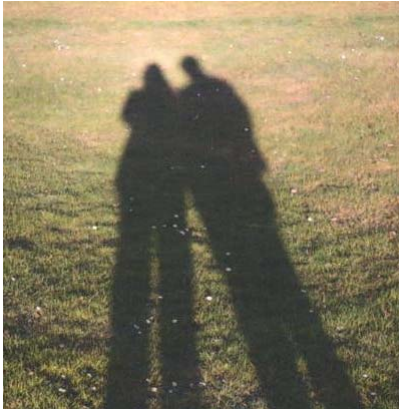
What was he writing, we may never know,
